Introductions:

Update from the Medical Examiner's Office:

New manual for the team put out by Childrens Health Alliance of Wisconsin. Please review the manual prior to next meeting in April.

Sleep baby safe and snug book was approved by rotary club. \$120.00 approved for us to purchase. An order blank has been included in packet of information this morning.

2014 activity summary:

Several SID/co-sleeping deaths, all numbers not in as yet. PJ Schoebel will send out prior to next meeting.

Safe Sleep continues to be an issue and should be one of the main concerns for this committee and the Dodge County City of Watertown CARES coalition.

Pack n Plays are used in the home with some of the SIDS deaths; we need to find out why they haven't been used when there is a death of an infant due to unsafe sleep.

Public Health:

Pack n play demonstration for set up and take down.

Safe sleep brochures to distribute at agencies who attend CDR as well as those agencies involved with the Dodge County City of Watertown CARES coalition

First Breath/second hand smoking issue is address with women who are on the Prenatal Care Coordination Program, WIC and also anytime a Public Health Nurse provides home visits.

Public Health has seen an increase in Influenza cases, even those who have received the Influenza vaccine. There has been a slight shift in the virus which makes the vaccine not as effective. Wisconsin saw its first pediatric death due to influenza. Public Health is promoting vaccination to all individuals 6 months or older.

Law Enforcement:

Mental Health:

Additional 5 therapists are being hired

We are locating some of the therapists in the schools

TAD: (Treatment, Alternative, Diversion Program)

2 new therapists were hired to the staff. They will deal with the heroin issue. There is such an Opiate problem at this time and this will help to get people in for treatment and therapy. Provide more options for those that are affected.

2 of the Psychiatrists are focusing on adults. Dodge County is in need of a child psychiatrist, and they are working to get one on staff.

We have 5 new AODA staff that will be working with TAD and Drug and Alcohol Treatment.

Psych Associates:

Grief relief: we want to get in the middle and high school, but we are having problems getting volunteers to train and run this. YMCA has volunteered to give the program space to hold the sessions.

Fond Du Lacs grief relief program is up and running.

Working with church health and Beaver Dam ImpAct and would like to work with Dodge County Human Services to pool resources.

Article shows children have difficult time dealing with loss.

Human Services and health:

Staff is working with state regarding child welfare cases and how to identify communication issues and how to better services to their client's needs.

Stat. 48.78(2)(a) (restricting redisclosure of information in records of child protective agency); and Wis. Stat. 48.396 (limiting disclosure of law enforcement records of children).
