PRESS RELEASE – MOTOR VEHICLE CRASH

On 06-22-16 at 3:41 am, the Dodge County Sheriff's Office responded to a motor vehicle crash on St. Helena Road north of Arrowhead Trail in the Township of Hustisford, Dodge County, Wisconsin.

Preliminary investigation shows that Ryan Rhadans (34 years old, from Watertown, WI) was operating a 2001 Lincoln and traveling south on St. Helena Road entering a curve in the roadway. The vehicle went off of the roadway, struck an embankment and vaulted. The vehicle struck a tree and overturned. Rhadans suffered life threatening injuries and was flown from the scene by Flight for Life to Aurora Medical Center in Summit. A passenger in the vehicle, Timothy Bradfield (33 years old from Juneau, WI) suffered life threatening injuries and was flown from the scene by Flight for Life helicopter to Froedert Hospital in Milwaukee.

Assisting at the scene were Hustisford and Neosho Fire Departments, Hustisford First Responders, Lebanon and Horicon EMS, Flight for Life, Dodge County Emergency Response Team.

The crash remains under investigation by the Dodge County Crash Investigation Team.
