The event was sponsored by the United States Customs and Border Protection and offered our explorers many different challenges and events to compete in on the national level. They competed against other explorers from across the nation. The event was attended by six Explorers including Captain Bradley Kulibert of Mayville, Lieutenant Easton Meier of Beaver Dam, Sergeant Megan Falkingham of Beaver Dam, Sergeant Scott Anderson of Beaver Dam, Quinton Rennhack of Clyman and Grant Allar of Beaver Dam.

The explorers competed in several team events including Bomb Threat Response, White Collar Crimes, Crime Prevention, Crime Scene Investigation and Arrest and Search. Our own Easton Meier took home a 2nd place award in a physical agility competition for explorers between the ages of 14-16 years old. This event also proved to be a tremendous networking tool for deputies who attended as chaperones for the explorers. While in Arizona the Explorers were able to visit the Grand Canyon among other tourist sites including a cave formed from lava.
