## **UPDATED PRESS RELEASE – FATAL MOTOR VEHICLE CRASH**

On 05-17-17 at 8:32 AM, the Dodge County Sheriff's Office responded to a motor vehicle versus semi (with box trailer) crash on STH 67 at the intersection with Town Road MM in the Township of Ashippun, Dodge County, Wisconsin.

Preliminary investigation shows that John G. Armentrout (28 years old, from Juneau, WI) was operating a 2002 Pontiac traveling west on Town Road MM approaching the intersection with STH 67 (this direction of travel is controlled by a posted stop sign at the intersection). Kimberly A. Jacobs (51 years old, from Chilton, WI) was operating a 2016 Freightliner semi with box trailer traveling north on STH 67, approaching the intersection with Town Road MM. The Pontiac entered the intersection and was struck by the semi. Armentrout was not restrained and was ejected from the vehicle. The semi burst into flames shortly after impact and then went off of the east side of the roadway and struck several trees before coming to rest.

Jacobs sustained non-life threatening injuries and was transported to Aurora Hospital in Summit. Armentrout was pronounced dead at the scene by the Dodge County Medical Examiner.

STH 67 at the Town Road MM intersection was closed for almost 4 hours while the crash was being investigated and the scene being cleared. The roadway was again partially closed around 1:30 PM as the fire in the semi reignited and had to be extinguished by Ashippun Fire Department.

Assisting at the scene were Wisconsin State Patrol, Ashippun Fire and First Responders, Neosho and Hustisford Fire Departments, Lebanon EMS and the Dodge County Emergency Response Team.

The crash remains under investigation by the Dodge County Medical Examiner and the Dodge County Crash Investigation Team. Additional information can be obtained by contacting Sheriff Dale J Schmidt.
