Motion to Recommend to Finance to use Jail Improvement Funds to Remodel Officer Station Pod A a motion was made by Kira Sheaham-Malloy and seconded by Mark Roesch to recommend to Finance to use Jail Improvement Funds to remodel officer station Pod A in the amount of \$8,817.50. Motion carried.
