Joel Thomas, the 2012 WI Governor's Council on Financial Literacy award winner, founder of the Financial Resiliency Foundation, and schools manager for EverFi provides this summary of his presentation: No one profits from poor financial decision making, not citizens, not banks, and certainly not schools. Simply put, better financially educated citizens make better informed financial decisions allowing them to contribute more to their local community and economy. As Ben Bernanke pointed out in 2008, "the key lesson from the global financial crisis is the lack of financial literacy". EverFi has certified over 4.5 million students across all 50 states in critical life skills such as financial literacy. EverFi provides 21st century financial literacy platforms to K-12 schools at no cost through private public partnership with banks and foundations.
