Public Comment: None


BDACT Grant Application: Sheriff Schmidt distributed a copy of the official grant application submitted by the Beaver Dam Area Community Theatre, Inc. / P.A.V.E. and C.A.R.E. (project partners) in the amount of \$3,800.00. Discussion followed regarding the content of the project. According to the application, the project description is, *"to dramatize the epidemic in Dodge County, BDACT, P.A.V.E. and C.A.R.E. will present, With One Voice: Letters from the Opioid Crisis Zone. This staged reading program will offer stories, poems, essays and testimonies solicited from victims, abusers, law enforcement officials, teachers, students, parents, health professionals, social service personnel and other resources. Relatable music by area performers will enhance the program. Immediately following, a panel of professionals will conduct an audience discussion. Information from relevant organizations will be available."*

Sheriff Schmidt noted that the Crime Prevention Board could have the opportunity to review the program readings prior to the program.

Motion by Glewen, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Kirshbaum to approve the application submitted by the Beaver Dam Area Community Theatre, Inc. / P.A.V.E. and C.A.R.E. (project partners) in the amount of \$3,800.00 and require a review / approval of the script. Motion carried unanimously.
