

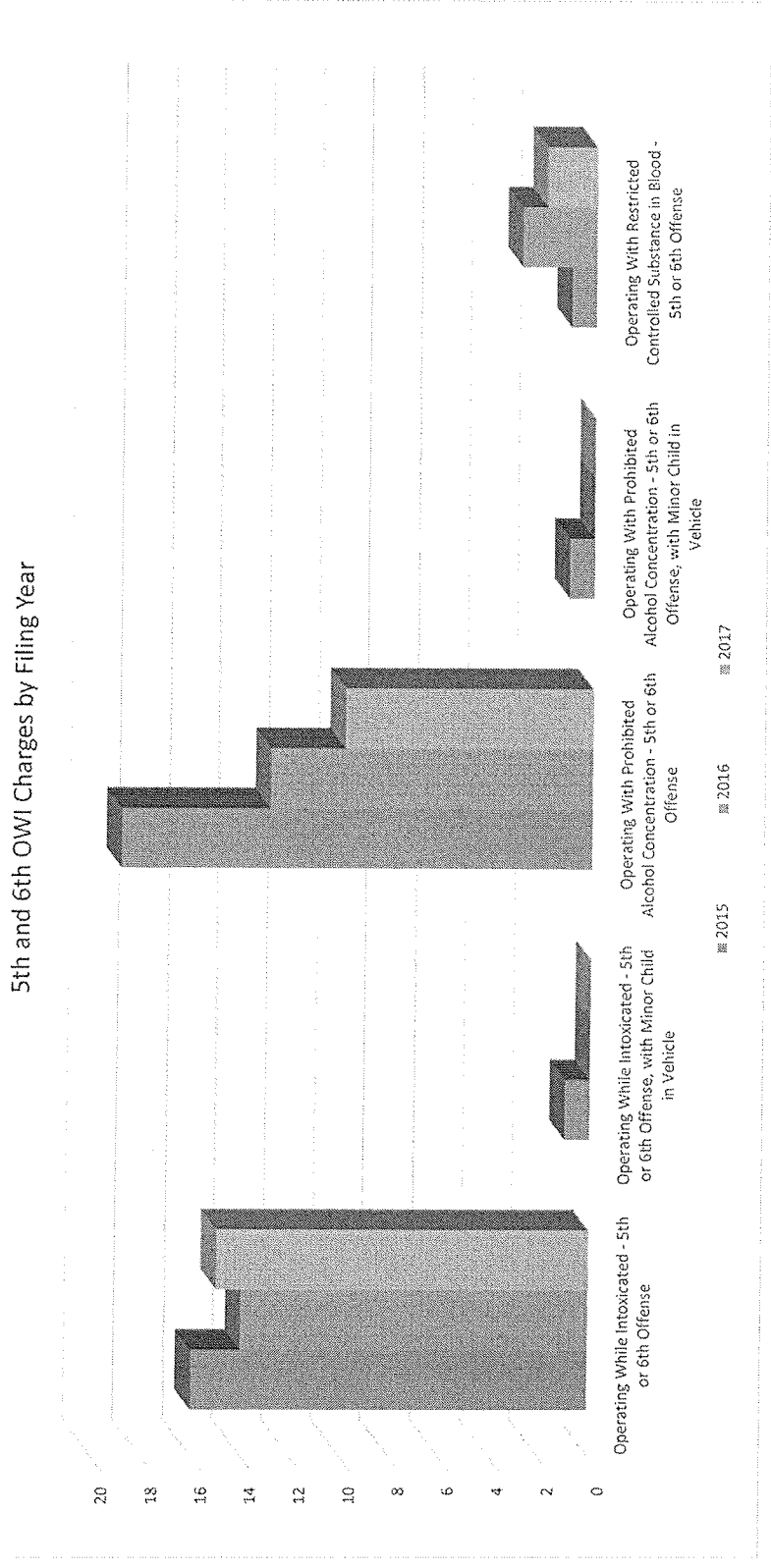

Minutes

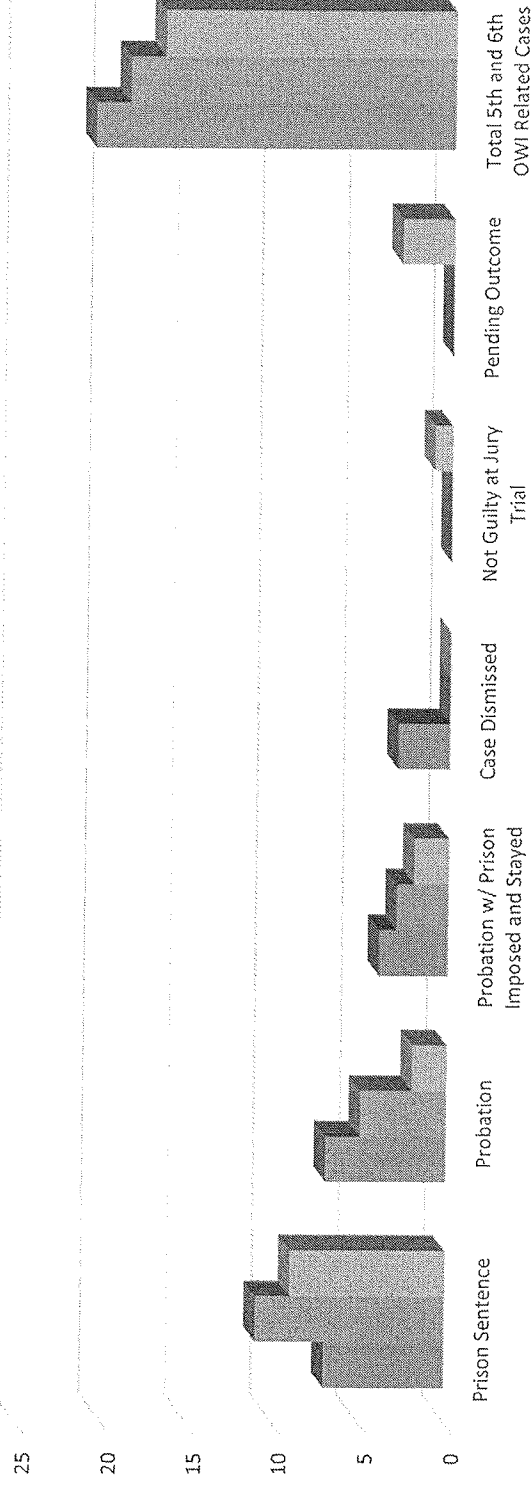
