The Senior Dining Programs are operated as a service through the Dodge County Human Services and Health Department.



The purpose of a **Senior Dining Center** is to offer residents of Dodge County, age 60 or older, a chance to enjoy a nutritious meal and other nutrition-related services. Meals are offered five days a week at dining centers throughout the county.

Home Delivered Meals are available to homebound elderly who meet federal eligibility requirements for this program.

The home delivered meal program offers a well-balanced meal to those unable to leave their home or find it hard to cook for themselves. It also offers participants contact with the smiling face of the home delivery driver in what can otherwise be a long day.

Meal Reservations

For home delivered meals, phone the office at **920-386-3580** or **800-924-6407**.

For anyone wishing to eat a meal at a dining center, a meal reservation must be made the day prior. These may be made either by signing up at the dining center or by phoning the office at **920-386-3580** or **800-924-6407**. Any person who comes to a dining center without a reservation can be served a meal only after ALL dining center participants who have a meal reservation have been served.



Days of Operation

The Senior Dining Programs operate Monday through Friday each week from 11 - 12:30 pm with the exception of the following holidays: New Year's Day, Spring Holiday (Friday before Easter), Memorial Day, 4th of July, Labor Day, Thanksgiving, Day after Thanksgiving, Christmas Eve, Christmas Day, and New Year's Eve.

The Senior Dining Programs meals are cancelled when weather conditions make traveling hazardous. Local radio and television stations announce dining center closings.

Menus

The Senior Dining Programs menu is listed weekly in local newspapers. They are also announced daily on the following radio stations: 1430 AM WBEV, 95.3 FM WXRO, 1540 AM WTKM, and 104.9 FM WTKM. You may also phone the office to ask about the menu.

Cost of the Meal

Based on the Older Americans Act, dining center participants are encouraged to make a voluntary donation towards the cost of the meal. No participant will be denied a meal if they are unable to make a donation.
