Procedures for Temporary holding tank requests because of wet weather

The following procedure will be used by the County for requests for the use of a septic tank as a temporary holding tanks to serve structures that are ready for occupancy, but soil moisture conditions preclude the installation of the mound/at-grade/in-ground POWTS component.

- 1. A sanitary permit must have been issued by the County for the proposed POWTS.
 - Under this permit, the property owner, via their plumber, may request that the tank portion of the approved POWTS permit be installed and converted into a temporary holding tank system.
- 2. The plumber shall submit plans to the County with a request to allow the conversion of the septic and/or pump chamber tank to a temporary holding tank.
 - The plans must include details on how the tank(s) will be converted into temporary holding tanks such as
 access covers brought above grade, locking provisions for the access covers, high water alarms, and
 plugging of the outlet openings.
 - A valid servicing contract shall be submitted with the plans.
 - A valid Emergency holding tank agreement shall be submitted with the plans. The emergency holding tank agreement shall stipulate a date by which the originally approved POWTS will be completed.

Please Note: If the sanitary permit will expire prior to the potential installation of the soil-based POWTS, the plumber will need to renew the permit prior to its expiration date.

No additional sanitary permit fee will be charged by the County for the conversion of the septic tank and/or pump chamber into a temporary holding tank, however, if the permit needs to be renewed, the normal permit renewal fee will apply.
