## Dodge County Board of Supervisors January 21, 2020 – 7:00 p.m. Administration Building - Juneau, Wisconsin

The January Session of the Dodge County Board of Supervisors was called to order by Chairman Russell Kottke at 7:00 p.m.

The Board rose to say the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll call was taken by the Clerk with all Supervisors being in attendance with the exception of Supervisors Behl, Schaefer, Schraufnagel and Sheahan-Malloy who had previously asked to be excused.

Chairman Kottke called for approval of the minutes. A motion was made by Supervisor Nickel and seconded by Supervisor Greshay to approve the minutes of the December 17, 2019, session of the County Board meeting as recorded, and dispense with the reading of the minutes. The motion passed by acclamation with no negative votes cast, and was so ordered by the Chairman.

#### **Communications on File**

Karen J. Gibson, County Clerk, reported there were no communications on file.

## **Special Orders of Business**

Chairman Kottke called the First Order of Business: Confirm Appointment made by County Board Administrator, James Mielke. Appoint Scott Smith to the position of Dodge County Highway Safety Coordinator effective January 14, 2020. Scott Smith will serve at the pleasure of the County Administrator. A motion to accept the appointment was made by Supervisor Maly and seconded by Supervisor Miller. The motion passed by acclamation with no negative votes cast, thereby approving the appointment.

Chairman Kottke called upon Marie Witzel, 4-H/Youth Development Educator who named the 2019 4-H Key Award winners: Kendra Gillett, Marshall McGauley and Faith Rinzel. Kendra Gillett, Marshall McGauley (via video as he was unable to attend) and Faith Rinzel (via video as she was unable to attend) addressed the County Board of Supervisors, telling them about their many 4-H experiences and also thanking the board and citizens of Dodge County for their support of the 4-H program. Chairman Kottke congratulated Ms. Gillett and presented her with a commendation certificate recognizing her 4-H key award achievement. Ms. Witzel presented Ms. Gillett with a letter from Governor Tony Evers' Office, a certificate of special senatorial recognition from Senator Ronald Johnson and a citation from the State of Wisconsin from Representative Jon Plumer.

Chairman Kottke called upon Amy Nehls, Emergency Management Director who introduced Dana Sechler, Vice President of Strategic Management & Consulting. Mr. Sechler gave a presentation on the Dodge County EMS Study. He outlined the Ambulance System and EMS Operations Evaluation, Review, Findings and Recommendations prepared by Strategic Management & Consulting. Questions by Supervisors Derr and J. Schmitt answered by Mr. Sechler. Comment by Supervisor J. Schmitt.

A motion for adoption was made by Supervisor Marsik and seconded by Supervisor Greshay. Comment by Supervisor D. Schmidt. The vote was cast with all voting in the affirmative, thereby adopting the Resolution.

Resolution No. 19-62 Resolution Authorizing the Construction and Internal Borrowing for the Reeseville Highway Shop – Highway Committee. A motion for adoption was made by Supervisor Caine and seconded by Supervisor Frohling. Supervisor Frohling made a motion to amend Resolution 19-62 by striking the words "and interest" on Page 2, line 34 and on Page 3, line 20 and adding a No. 6 to Page 3 to read: The Dodge County Highway Department shall budget for annual interest payments in each of the following years: 2021, 2022, 2023, 2024 and 2025. The motion to amend was seconded by Supervisor Caine. Kimberly Nass, Corporation Counsel advised the Board that she prepared a revised resolution with the amendment which was being placed on their desks. Question by Supervisor J. Schmitt answered by Chairman Kottke, Kimberly Nass, Corporation Counsel and Supervisor Frohling. The vote was cast with all voting in the affirmative, thereby adopting the motion to amend.

Question by Supervisor J. Schmitt answered by Brian Field, Highway Commissioner. Supervisor J. Schmitt made a motion to amend Resolution 19-62 by changing the amount of \$3,468,317 to \$3,559,311 on Page 2, lines 12, 20 and 23 and on Page 3, lines 4, 6, 9 and 30. Exhibits "B" & "C" were also amended to reflect said change. The motion to amend was seconded by Supervisor Maly. Kimberly Nass, Corporation Counsel distributed another revised resolution containing Supervisor Schmitt's amendment. Questions by Supervisors Glewen and Derr answered by Brian Field, Highway Commissioner and Supervisor J. Schmitt. Comments by Brian Field, Highway Commissioner and Supervisors J. Schmitt, Caine, Maly, Guckenberger and Greshay. The vote was cast with 23 ayes and 5 noes, thereby adopting the motion to amend

## County Project and Issue Update Volume 59 February 2020

<u>ERP Project</u>: The Dodge County Project Team continues to work with the Tyler implementation team to review Tickets / Open Cases and discuss areas for further training. As the go-live is now in week 8, the end users with hands on working experience are becoming more familiar with the system's capabilities.

Training has been scheduled in April for larger departments related to the budgeting module, followed by the remaining departments in June. The budget training timeline was purposefully scheduled in the April – June timeframe to provide an opportunity for department heads to have hands on experience prior to starting the budget module.

<u>Clearview Executive Director Recruitment</u>: First Round interviews are scheduled for Friday, February 21<sup>st</sup>. A total of six applicants have been invited to participate in the first round. The applicant pool did not include an internal candidate(s). The date of second interviews will be determined upon the completion of the first round of interviews.

The interview panel consists of: Health Facilities Chair Larry Bischoff, Clearview Administration team members Lori Kurtz; Jackie Kuhl and Heather Hurley. In addition, Sarah Hinze and I will participate in the interview process.

The goal is to present an appointment Resolution sponsored by the Health Facilities Committee to the County Board on March 17<sup>th</sup>. If the timeline does not enable an appointment Resolution to be presented at the March 17<sup>th</sup> meeting, the appointment Resolution would be brought forward on April 21<sup>st</sup>.

Proposed Shared Positions – Jefferson County: Discussions with the Jefferson County Administrator, Human Resource Director and Finance Director have and continue to take place with Sarah Hinze, David Ehlinger, Kim Nass and me regarding the potential for Dodge and Jefferson counties to share two distinct positions: Purchasing Agent and Risk Manager. Currently, Dodge County has a vacant funded Purchasing Agent position and Jefferson County has a vacant, budgeted Risk Manager / Safety Coordinator position.

The concept of shared positions has been reviewed with the Executive, Human Resource and Finance Committees. At this time, a business case document is being created through the combined resources of both counties. Various Jefferson County committees have reviewed the proposed shared positions.

The goal is to bring forward an official recommendation in either March or April. If approved by both counties, the shared positions would enable each county to acquire two skill sets which are not currently available in either county.

<u>Compensation Study</u>: The Job Description Questionnaire phase of the study has been completed. The Job Description Questionnaires will be made available to the McGrath team. Group meetings with employees will be scheduled in March.

# RESOLUTION NO. 19-63

## Resolution Ordering the Establishment of the Beaver Dam Lake District

TO THE HONORABLE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF DODGE COUNTY, WISCONSIN,

WHEREAS, the Dodge County Board of Supervisors received a Petition requesting the Dodge County Board of Supervisors establish a Public Inland Lake Protection and Rehabilitation District for Beaver Dam Lake pursuant to Chapter 33, of the *Wisconsin Statutes*, the boundary of such Public Inland Lake Protection and Rehabilitation District being described in Exhibit "A", which is attached hereto and incorporated herein; and,

WHEREAS, the above-described Petition was received by the Dodge County Board of Supervisors on September 10, 2019; and,

WHEREAS, at its meetings on September 17, 2019, the Dodge County Board of Supervisors appointed the Land Resources and Parks Committee for purposes of conducting a public hearing regarding the Petition, as required by § 33.26(1), Wis. Stats., and preparing a report; and,

WHEREAS, such public hearing was held on October 3, 2019, by the Land Resources and Parks Committee; and,

WHEREAS, the Land Resources and Parks Committee, having considered the Petition, the public hearing testimony, the written statements submitted to it, and the requirements of the Chapter 33, of the *Wisconsin Statutes*, has prepared a Report as required by § 33.26(3), Wis. Stats.; and,

WHEREAS, a copy of the Land Resources and Parks Committee Report is attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit "B"; and,

### WHEREAS, the Land Resources and Parks Committee finds:

- 1. That a Petition requesting the formation of a Public Inland Lake Protection and Rehabilitation District for Beaver Dam Lake was received by the Dodge County Board of Supervisors on September 10, 2019;
- 2. That a public hearing was held on October 3, 2019, at the Dodge County Administration Building to receive testimony and statements regarding the Petition;
- 3. That the Land Resources and Parks Department and Dodge County Clerk staff determined the total number of valid signatures consisting of at least 51% of landowners in the proposed District is 714, and that 730 valid signatures were presented;

- 4. That the Petition to form the District was signed by the requisite number of owners as required by § 33.25, Wis. Stats.;
- 5. That the proposed District is necessary;
- 6. That public health, comfort, convenience, necessity and public welfare will be promoted by the establishment of the District;
- 7. That the property to be included in the District as proposed by the Petition will be benefited by the District's establishment; and,
- 8. That the proposed boundaries of the District are as described on the attached map/sketch, attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit "A";
- **SO, NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** by the Dodge County Board of Supervisors that after consideration of the Land Resources and Park Committee's Report and other evidence submitted to the Dodge County Board of Supervisors, the Dodge County Board of Supervisors adopts the following findings:
  - 1. That a Petition requesting the formation of a Public Inland Lake Protection and Rehabilitation District for Beaver Dam Lake was received by the Dodge County Board of Supervisors on September 10, 2019;
  - 2. That a public hearing was held on October 3, 2019, at the Dodge County Administration Building to receive testimony and statements regarding the Petition, which public hearing was conducted in accordance with the required statutory time limits;
  - 3. That the Land Resources and Parks Department and Dodge County Clerk staff determined the total number of valid signatures consisting of at least 51% of landowners in the proposed District is 714, and that 730 valid signatures were presented;
  - 4. That the Land Resources and Parks Committee prepared and submitted a Report, attached hereto as Exhibit "B", as required by § 33.26(3), Wis. Stats., which Report was submitted in accordance with the required statutory time limits;
  - 5. That the Petition to form the District was signed by the requisite number of owners as required by § 33.25, Wis. Stats.;
  - 6. That the proposed District is necessary;
  - 7. That public health, comfort, convenience, necessity and public welfare will be promoted by the establishment of the District;

- 8. That the property to be included in the District as proposed by the Petition will be benefited by the District's establishment; and.
- 9. That the proposed boundaries of the District are as described on the attached map/sketch, attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit "A"; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Dodge County Board of Supervisors accepts the Report of Land Resources and Parks Committee as presented on December 17, 2019; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that it is ordered by the Dodge County Board of Supervisors, pursuant to Chapter 33, of the Wisconsin Statutes, that the Beaver Dam Lake District is hereby organized and established; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that it is ordered by the Dodge County Board of Supervisors, pursuant to Chapter 33, of the Wisconsin Statutes, that the boundaries of the Beaver Dam Lake District are hereby established as those described on the attached map/sketch, attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit "A"; and,

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that it is ordered by the Dodge County Board of Supervisors, pursuant to Chapter 33, of the Wisconsin Statutes, that the District shall be a body corporate to the extent provided by Chapter 33, of the Wisconsin Statutes, and shall be known as the Beaver Dam Lake District.

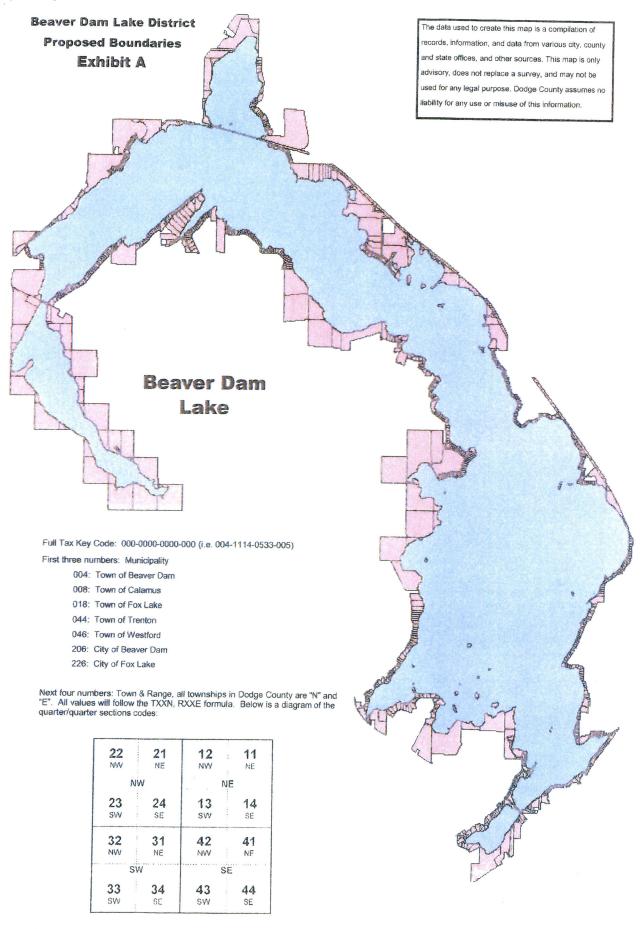

TO THE HONORABLE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF DODGE COUNTY, WISCONSIN,

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 33 of the *Wisconsin Statutes*, a Petition was submitted to the Dodge County Board of Supervisors by filing same with the Dodge County Clerk on September 10, 2019, requesting the establishment of a Public Inland Lake Protection and Rehabilitation District to be known as the Beaver Dam Lake District; and,

WHEREAS, said Petition states that the proposed District is necessary to deal with the complex resource problems associated with the Beaver Dam Lake, including poor water quality, eroding shorelines, excessive carp, algae outbreaks, periodic excessive growth of invasive aquatic plants, and non-point runoff of sediment and nutrients into the lake; and,

WHEREAS, on September 17, 2019, at a regular meeting of the Dodge County Board of Supervisors, the Land Resources and Parks Committee was appointed by the Dodge County Board of Supervisors to conduct a public hearing on said Petition and prepare a report to the Dodge County Board of Supervisors; and,

WHEREAS, a Public Hearing was conducted on October 3, 2019, at 5:30 p.m., in the First Floor Auditorium, Rooms F, G, H, and I of the Dodge County Administration Building, located at 127 E. Oak Street, Juneau, Wisconsin; and,

WHEREAS, the Dodge County Land Resources and Parks Committee makes the following Report to the Dodge County Board of Supervisors and submits same within three (3) months of the public hearing as required by § 33.26(3), Wis. Stats.;

#### REPORT

#### Petition.

On September 10, 2019, a Petition was submitted to the Dodge County Board of Supervisors by filing with the Dodge County Clerk requesting the establishment of an Inland Lake Protection and Rehabilitation District pursuant to § 33.21, Wis. Stats. (Attachment Nos. 1 and 2). As required by § 33.25(2), Wis. Stats., the Petition contains all of the following:

- 1. Proposed name of the district: Beaver Dam Lake District;
- 2. A description of the necessity of the proposed district;
- 3. That public health, comfort, convenience, necessity or public welfare will be promoted by the establishment of the district and the lands proposed to be included in the district will be benefited; and,
- 4. A map/sketch of the proposed district boundaries and a list of Parcel Identification Numbers (PINs) associated with the lands to be included in the proposed district.

#### Validation of Signatures.

Upon receipt of the Petition, Dodge County staff began the signature validation process. Karen Gibson, Dodge County Clerk, and David Addison, Land Information Manager, independently

conducted the validation process and met thereafter to review the results. Because the Petition was submitted in 2019, the 2018 tax roll for the affected municipalities was used to identify landowners in the proposed district and determine signature validity. Dodge County staff reported the following:

- 1. Total number of landowners in the proposed district according to the 2018 tax roll=1.399:
- 2. Total number of signatures needed to achieve at least 51% of landowners in the proposed district=714;
- 3. Total number of valid signatures obtained=730; and,
- 4. The Petition contains the requisite number of valid signatures.

#### Public Notice.

At its meeting on September 17, 2019, the Land Resources and Parks Committee scheduled the public hearing on the petition for October 3, 2019, at 5:30 p.m. The public hearing date falls within thirty (30) days of receipt of the petition as required by § 33.26(1), Wis. Stats. A public hearing notice was prepared, mailed, and published (Attachment No. 3). On September 20, 2019, the Dodge County Clerk's Office mailed the public hearing notice to landowners in the proposed district, whose name and address appeared on the December, 2018 Dodge County tax roll. The Department of Natural Resources was notified by mail of the public hearing date. Notice of the public hearing, as required by § 33.26(2), Wis. Stats., was published in the Beaver Dam Daily Citizen on September 23, 2019 (Attachment No. 4).

## Summary of Written Statements Submitted.

Prior to or on October 3, 2019, the following information was received in the Dodge County Clerk's Office:

- 1. Written comments from twenty-nine (29) individuals who are opposed to the establishment of the Beaver Dam Lake District.
- 2. Written comments from thirteen (13) individuals who are in favor of the Beaver Dam Lake District.
- 3. Written comments from one (1) individual who does not appear to be opposed or in favor of the Beaver Dam Lake District, but instead provided suggestions or questions.
- 4. The County Clerk received no written requests to withdraw from the petition from landowners who signed the petition. Pursuant to §33.25(5), Wis. Stats., such written notices are required to be filed at least 10 days prior to the date of the public hearing.

#### Public Hearing Conducted.

On October 3, 2019, at 5:30 p.m., the Public Hearing was conducted by the Dodge County Land Resources and Parks Committee in the Dodge County Administration Building, located at 127 E. Oak Street, Juneau, Wisconsin. Thomas Schaefer, Committee Chair, convened the meeting at approximately 5:30 p.m. After roll call, the Dodge County Corporation Counsel reviewed the role of Dodge County in the process to form a lake district. Thereafter, a presentation was given by Michael Engleson, Wisconsin Lakes Executive Director. Finally, representatives from the Beaver Dam Lake Improvement Association presented the Petition to the Committee. The Committee Chair

then reviewed the procedures for public hearing testimony and declared the public hearing open. Approximately 38 people signed in at the registration table to provide testimony. During the Public Hearing, the Dodge County Clerk called the names of the individuals present wishing to provide testimony. Names were called in the order in which they were received. Approximately 20 registered to speak in favor, 18 requested to speak in opposition, or provided general comments during the public hearing. Not all registrants, however, provided testimony. A court reporter recorded the public hearing testimony and a transcript was prepared (Attachment No. 5). Approximately 125 people attended the public hearing.

The Land Resources and Parks Committee Chair, after it appeared that all members of the public present wishing to comment had been given the opportunity to do so, declared the Public Hearing closed. Meeting minutes of the Land Resources and Parks Committee were prepared. (Attachment No. 5).

#### Summary of Public Hearing Testimony.

Thirty-eight (38) individuals registered to provide testimony; twenty (20) in favor and eighteen (18) opposed. Testimony of thirty-two (32) public speakers was given. According to the hearing transcript, nineteen (19) speakers testified in support of the formation of the Beaver Dam Lake District. Thirteen (13) speakers testified in opposition to the formation of the Beaver Dam Lake District.

Following are excerpts of testimony in favor of the formation of the lake district:

- A lake district is a formal, structured organization with taxing authority and governance set by law; provides structural and financial strength to take on the challenges of the lake;
- Provides for an organized effort to address the increase in phosphorus in the lake which spurs algae growth; public health will be improved when the algae blooms are controlled or eliminated;
- Ability to control or eradicate aquatic invasive species in and around the lake;
- Lake district commissioners provide continuity for the organization unlike volunteer leaders and members of a lake association:
- Ability to improve water quality and natural habitat for foul and fish;
- Ability to maintain the lake for the enjoyment of those who live around it and for the general public for water recreation such as swimming, boating, jet skiing, water skiing, paddle boarding, kayaking, fishing, enjoying the natural beauty/quality of life;
- Improve the lake and maintain property values;
- A lake district has access to grant opportunities and other sources to fund, in conjunction with tax revenues, water quality initiatives; ability to tap into DNR resources;
- The proposed district includes approximately 800 properties which will provide a reasonable tax base without overburdening lake property owners;
- Property owners within the lake district will have a voice in the management of the lake; voting rights to elect commissioners, set budgets, establish lake management plans and priorities;
- Beaver Dam Chamber of Commerce, on behalf of the business community, supports the lake district as a means to provide a healthy lake which will attract users of the lake for fishing,

boating and recreation; quality of life in the County which may attract new residents to grow the County tax base;

- Healthy lake with improved water quality will maintain and improve property values for all;
- A lake district has the strength to take action to address issues so that all can enjoy the lake; ability to develop and implement lake management plans and projects;
- Promote public health by encouraging water activities/recreation; will attract people to the area, tourism; and,
- Coordinated efforts, working in collaboration with farmers and agricultural associations to address run-off, fertilizers/phosphorus (natural and chemical) entering the lake.

Following are excerpts of testimony opposed to the formation of the lake district:

- Don't want another tax; all properties in the area should be included not just those parcels that touch the lake;
- Algae blooms are due to non-point source pollution; fertilizer; run-off from farm fields; bad farming practices like spreading treated sewage on fields;
- Object to the petition process; signatures were not obtained in a timely fashion; petitioners made false promises and engaged in a sales job to get signatures;
- The lake is a marsh and cannot be fixed; lake district will not eliminate the algae, bullheads, carp, weeds;
- Need to address the entire watershed in order to address the water quality;
- City of Beaver Dam storm sewers discharge into the lake; this needs to be addressed to improve water quality; double tax on water discharge;
- Many sources contribute to lake problems, everyone (local community, businesses, general public, lake property owners) benefits from improved water quality and a healthy lake; everyone is responsible for the care of the lake; burden should not just be on lake property owners; lake property taxes are already too high; don't want to pay more taxes; and,
- Another government entity; duplication of government; let the DNR take care of the lake; enforce regulations to improve water quality.

At the conclusion of the Public Hearing, the Beaver Dam Chamber of Commerce submitted a resolution in support of the formation of the lake district (Attachment No. 6).

#### **FINDINGS**

Based on a review of the Petition submitted on September 10, 2019, requesting the formation of the Beaver Dam Lake District, the validation process undertaken by staff of the signatures included on the Petition, the Public Hearing testimony offered on October 3, 2019, a review of the complete transcript of the Public Hearing, a review of all timely submitted written statements/comments, the Land Resources and Parks Committee hereby finds that there is sufficient evidence to support the following findings:

1. The Petition is signed by the requisite number of owners of land in the proposed district. According to the 2018 tax rolls for the affected taxing districts, there are 1,399 landowners in the proposed district. The total number of signatures needed to achieve at

least 51% of landowners in the proposed district is 714. The total number of valid signatures obtained is 730.

- 2. The proposed district is necessary. The Committee heard testimony describing the limitations of a lake association organization and the benefits of forming a lake district. Testimony was presented indicating that it is now necessary to form a district to overcome the limitations of an association. The district, as a formal, recognized unit of government governed by statute with representation by all property owners within the boundaries, is necessary for the establishment and advancement of the lake management plans and priorities to provide the best opportunity to improve the quality of the lake for the benefit of all. The district will have access to grant and other funding to implement lake management plans and priorities as decided by the owners within the district.
- 3. Public health, comfort, convenience, necessity of public welfare will be promoted by the establishment of the proposed district. The Committee heard testimony describing the benefits to the public health and welfare to be gained by improving water quality, controlling algae blooms by addressing erosion and run-off into the lake and controlling aquatic invasive species. In addition to the benefits to the lake property owners, the general public is benefited by access to a healthy lake for water recreational activities, potential increase in tourism which in turn may benefit local businesses and increase state and local sales tax revenues. There is agreement, even by those opposed, that the lake is degraded. The Committee believes that the formation of the district provides the best opportunity to address water quality, algae blooms, aquatic invasive species and other lake concerns.
- 4. The property proposed to be included in the proposed district will be benefited by the establishment of the proposed district. On the whole, parcels included in the proposed district will benefit by its formation. Property owners within the proposed district are afforded representation to establish plans, priorities and an annual budget to promote improved water quality, fish and wildlife habitats, control aquatic invasive species and to promote collaboration among stakeholders.
- 5. The proposed boundaries of the district are as described on the attached map/sketch. (Attachment No. 7).

#### RECOMMENDATION

The Land Resources and Parks Committee does hereby recommend to the Dodge County Board of Supervisors that, by County Board Resolution, an Order be issued to establish the Beaver Dam Lake District, and that the district be established with the same boundaries as those proposed in the original Petition to form the Beaver Dam Lake District (Attachment No. 6).

The Land Resources and Parks Committee does further recommend that the Dodge County Board of Supervisors require the district to provide a legal description identifying the district boundaries and lands to be included, consistent with the parcels listed in the Petition.

Submitted with this letter are 744 verified petitions supporting the Dodge County Board's establishment of the Beaver Dam Lake District under Chapter 33 of the Wisconsin Statutes. Each signatory is an owner of property within the proposed District as defined in Section 33.01(9)(ar) or the referenced spouse of such an owner.

The petitions are numbered and sorted by township/city in parcel ID order with the exception of petitions 741 - 744 which were received after we sorted by tax parcel and are in a separate folder at the end.

The Beaver Dam Lake Improvement Association conducted an extensive program to inform property owners about the proposed Lake District and solicit support for its formation. That program consisted of three phases:

1. Letters were sent to all property owners with attachments showing the proposed lake district, the reasons for the formation of a district, a petition and a return envelope

2. Eight public meetings were conducted where property owners were invited to get more information on the proposed district as well as ask questions.

3. Twelve Association volunteers visited property owners personally at their Beaver Dam Lake homes.

The effort to establish the District was also discussed in numerous articles in the local newspaper and updates and articles in the Beaver Dam Lake Improvement Associations newsletter, which was mailed to all 1,095 lake parcels. It was also presented at the association's annual meeting and at the monthly board meetings, which are all open to the public. The association membership overwhelmingly supports the formation of the district as indicated by the fact that 94% of members eligible to sign have signed the petition.

Under Section 33.26 the County is charged to consider a Lake District Petition signed by 51 percent of the qualified property owners. A careful review of the 2018 Tax Rolls of the Towns of Fox Lake, Trenton, Calamus, Beaver Dam and Westford and the City of Beaver Dam shows a total of 1381 persons eligible to sign the petition. Of those, we have

learned of 23 listed owners are now deceased, leaving a total of 1358 potential petition signatories. The 744 petitions submitted with this letter thus constitute 54.8% of the eligible signatories.

The boundaries of the proposed District include some territory within the City of Beaver Dam. As required under Section 33.24(2) (a), the Beaver Dam City Council approved the inclusion of the portion of the proposed District within its jurisdiction by a Resolution adopted April 16, 2018.

In the meetings with the property owners most agreed that the structure of a lake district provides stronger lake management with all lake owners having an opportunity to participate and gives greater ability to leverage state and federal sources for protecting and improving Beaver Dam Lake.

Our Association is aware that the statutory timetable for proceedings to form the Lake District requires speedy action by the County Board and staff. We stand ready to assist in that process as you request. We appreciate the County's consideration and hope the District can be established promptly and begin its important mission of protecting Beaver Dam Lake for generations to come.

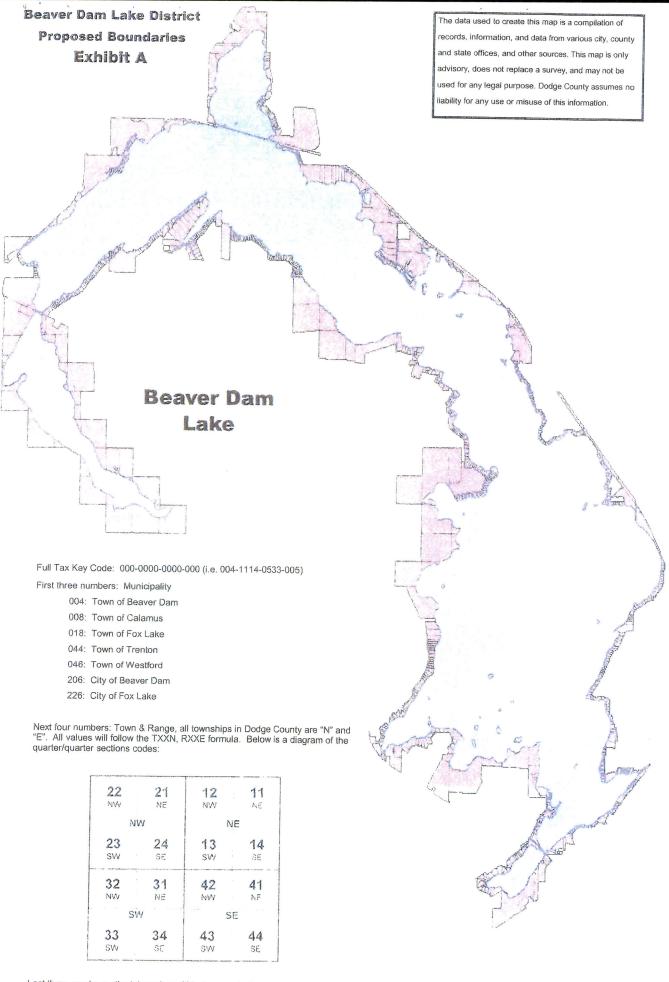

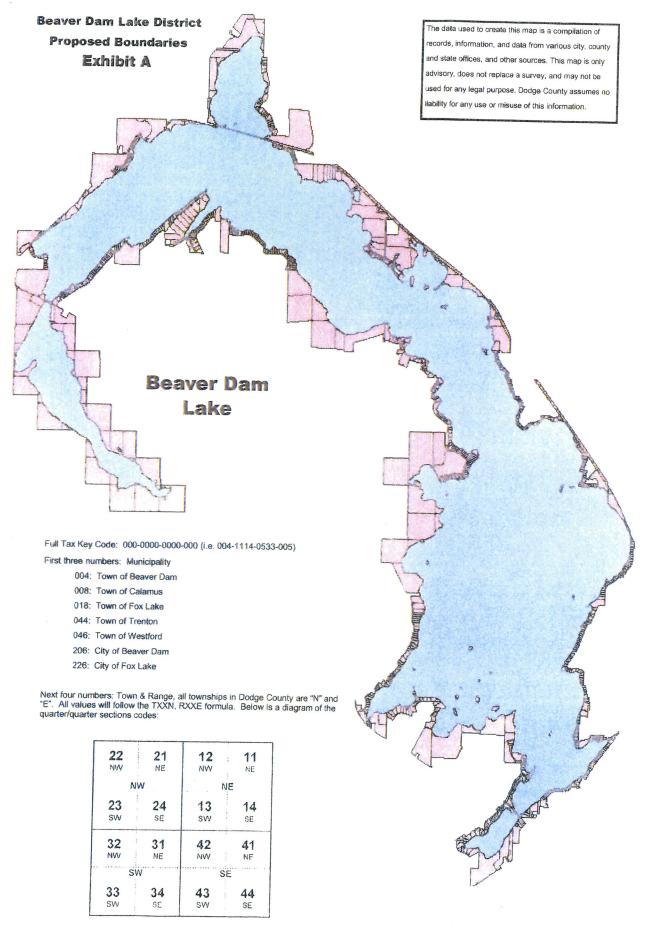

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# Resolution Authorizing the Purchase and Financing of the 2020 Computer and Infrastructure Refresh Project

TO THE HONORABLE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF DODGE COUNTY, WISCONSIN,

WHEREAS, the Dodge County Information Technology Committee ("Committee") has considered the current County Department computers and information technology server/network infrastructure and the maintenance and upgrades needed to prevent data loss, enhance user productivity and provide data and system securities; and,

WHEREAS, as proposed by the Information Technology Department ("IT Department"), the Committee has considered the following department and infrastructure upgrades: life-cycle refresh of department computers within the Dodge County Administration Building, Sheriff's Office, and also infrastructure refresh of servers and core networking hardware ("2020 Computer and Infrastructure Refresh Project"); and,

WHEREAS, the IT Department recommends a 4-year replacement cycle for County Department computers, and in the Fall of 2019, the IT Department inventoried County Department computers and determined that one hundred three (103) computers and related equipment require replacement, listed on a document entitled List of Department Computer Equipment, attached hereto as Exhibit "A", at a total cost, excluding interest, not to exceed \$152,339.24 with the cost spread over four (4) years of \$39,739.28 per year; and,

WHEREAS, in the Fall of 2019, the IT Department evaluated Dodge County's server and corenetworking infrastructure and determined that various system hardware require replacement, listed on a document entitled List of Servers and Network Hardware, attached hereto as Exhibit "B", at a total cost, excluding interest, not to exceed \$491,808.60 with the cost spread over four (4) years of approximately \$128,293.40 per year; and,

WHEREAS, the 2020 Computer and Network Infrastructure Refresh Project includes all hardware listed on the attached exhibits, warranty on all equipment, installation, and financing costs; and,

WHEREAS, the 2020 IT Department Budget has \$185,000 to fund the 2020 Computer and Infrastructure Refresh Project; and,

WHEREAS, the IT Department has explored funding sources and financing options for the 2020 Computer and Infrastructure Refresh Project, requested pricing from four different technology leasing and financing lenders as follows:

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WHEREAS, the IT Department presented its lease-to-own proposal to refresh department computers and network hardware and the various financing options to the Committee at its meeting on January 7, 2020, and also on February 4, 2020; and,

WHEREAS, the Committee recommends authorization of the 2020 Computer and Infrastructure Refresh Project in a total principal amount not to exceed \$644,147.84, and a 4-year lease-to-own agreement with American Capital to spread the costs over four (4) years of approximately \$168,032.68 per year; and,

WHEREAS, the Dodge County Finance Committee, at its meeting on February 17, 2020, considered the financing proposal for the 2020 Computer and Infrastructure Refresh Project at a total principal amount not to exceed \$644,147.84 and recommends entering into a 4-year financing agreement with American Capital with the requirement that the IT Department budget sufficient amounts in its annual budgets in 2021, 2022 and 2023 to cover the expenditures required by the agreement;

**SO, NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** by the Dodge County Board of Supervisors that it hereby adopts the recommendations of the Information Technology Committee and the Finance Committee, and authorizes the 2020 Computer and Infrastructure Refresh Project; and,

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** by the Dodge County Board of Supervisors that the County Administrator and County Clerk are authorized to execute a financing agreement presented by American Capital containing the following terms:

Purchase Finance Term: lease-to-own with dollar-buy-out

Total Principal Amount: \$644,147.84 Annual Lease-to-Own Payment: \$168,032.67

Number of Payments: four (4) total payments (2020, 2021, 2022, & 2023)

Total Lease Payments Amount: \$672,130.68
Interest Rate: 2.873%

### **Background:**

September 2018: The 2019 – 2023 Capital Improvement Plan, (Resolution 18-40) listed two projects related to Pod J. The projects included: *Razing Pod J*, \$125,000. Followed by, *Equipment Garage / Storage Facility* \$2,000,000.

August 2019: Dodge County entered into a contract with Angus Young (Janesville) for architectural and engineering services related to the Law Enforcement Center Repurposing Project. Mr. Steven Genin is the Angus Young lead for the project.

August 19, 2019: Angus Young provided a report – Feasibility Study – Equipment Storage and Training The report contain Budget Estimates for the Lower Level Renovation, with a project budget of \$502,500. A second budget estimate was provided to add a new garage door to the 1977 portion of the building, estimate of \$57,700. A third document was provided related to the construction of a new storage building to be located within the Juneau Highway Department yard. The budget estimate was \$843,400.

August 27, 2019: Itemized project budget proposal prepared for the Dodge County Board. Proposed total budget including contingency was set at \$850,000.

Sept 2019: Budget increased to \$940,000.

October 2019: The 2020 – 2024 Capital Improvement Plan (Resolution 19-47) listed the *Law Enforcement Center Equipment Garage / Storage Facility*, \$940,000.

**December 2019 - Project Bidding:** A Class II Bid Notice was published in December 2019 with a Bid due date of January 30, 2020. The Bid Notice included reference to a *Mandatory* pre-bid walk through scheduled for January 9, 2020. According to Russ Freber, 62 individuals representing general and subcontractors were present on January 9<sup>th</sup>. As a result of the large turnout, a second walk through for general and subcontractors was held on January 16<sup>th</sup>.

**January 30, 2020 Bid Opening:** Bids were opened and read aloud by County Clerk Karen Gibson. A total of seven (7) General Contractors submitted bids. The Bid package included the Base Bid and five alternates. A summary of the bid results is attached.

### February 6, 2020 Building Committee Meeting:

The Building Committee reviewed the project on February 6<sup>th</sup>. Mr. Genin of Angus Young was present to review the bidding process and results. He apologized to the Committee on behalf of Angus Young for underestimating the project cost estimate. Mr. Genin distributed his analysis documenting the Angus Young Cost Estimate and the low base bid received from the recommended project contractor. After discussion, the consensus of the Committee is to focus the project on the Base Bid, plus Alternates 1, 2, and 3.

In coordination with Corporation Counsel Kim Nass and Finance Director David Ehlinger, two Resolutions were presented. Each Resolution included the Base Bid, plus Alternates 1, 2, 3 for a total project budget of \$1,581,899 (includes contingency of 10%)

One Resolution funds the project through an Internal Borrowing carrying an interest rate of 1.9% with debt principal payments in years 2021 - 2025.

The second Resolution funds the project through the use of Unassigned Sales Tax Fund Balance.

The Building Committee signed both Resolutions with the understanding that one Resolution will be eliminated through action of the Dodge County Finance Committee.

<u>February 17, 2020 Finance Committee Meeting</u>: Angus Young Project Manager, Steven Genin appeared before the Finance Committee to review the project and the results of the January 30<sup>th</sup> project bid opening.

Questions were presented by the Committee regarding the original project estimate compared to the actual bid results. Mr. Genin referenced the February 6<sup>th</sup> Low Bid Analysis document. Following the discussion, the Finance Committee voted 3-1 (Supervisor Guckenberger - No) (Supervisor Benter – Excused) to recommend project funding be through the use of an internal borrowing; and the Committee will not take a position related to the project.

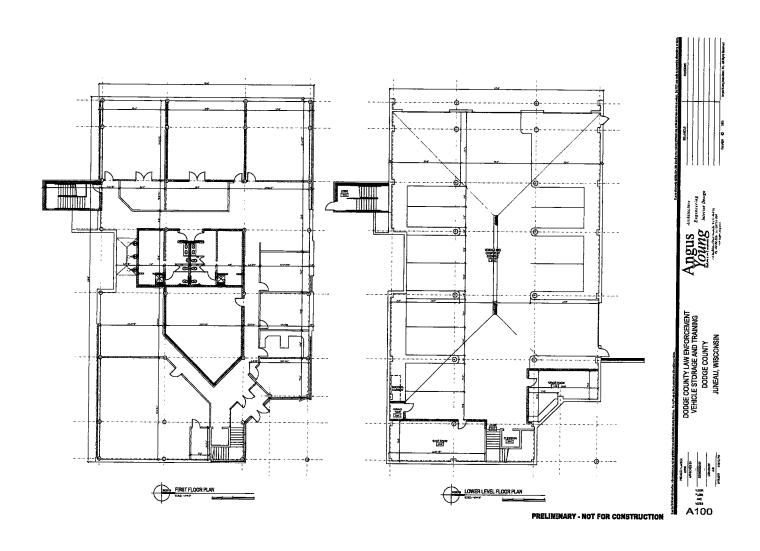

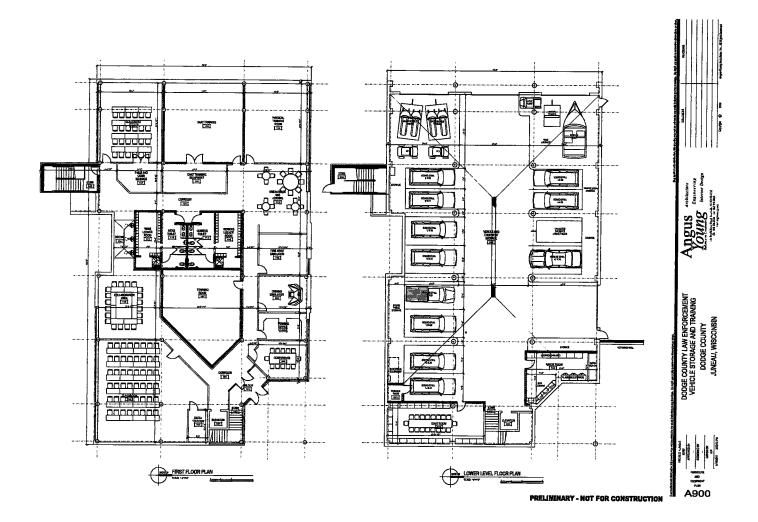

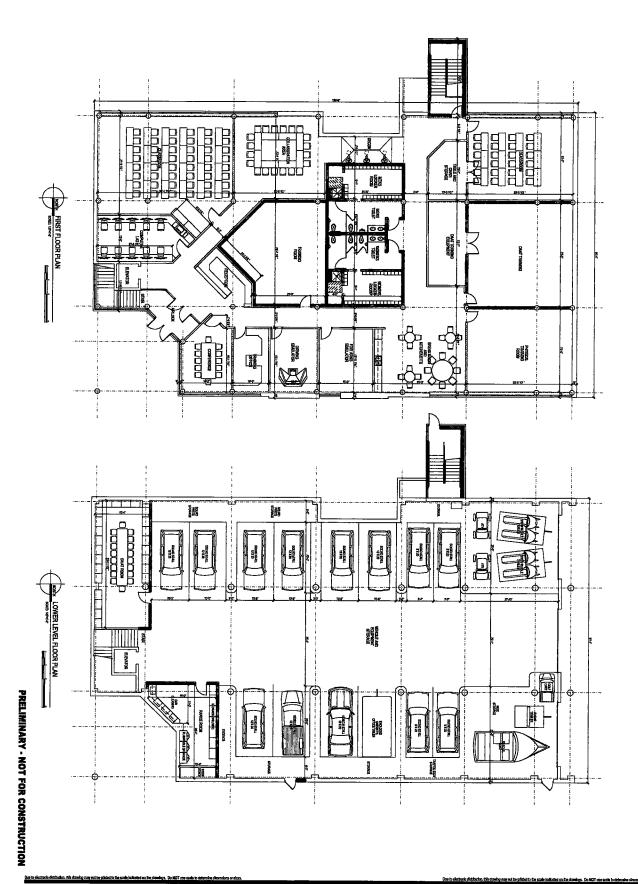

The lower level would be built out for storage needs and the first floor would remain unfinished until an appropriate use is determined.
