Program Changes/Notes:

1. No staff changes to report for this quarter.
2. Graduations: IDC: 3 participants graduated. The total for 2019 is 16.
DTC: 2 participants graduated. The total for 2019 is 9.
3. One Thinking for a Change classes concluded January 15 with 8 participants completing. Seven participants are in IDC and one is in DTC.
4. TAD grant contact for 2020 has been received for approval.

CJCC Update
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5. BJA update: There has been no activity to date as the release of funds is pending. The program evaluator from UW-Whitewater will conduct his on-site visit on April 16-17. The BJA Technical Assistance site visit will take place July 8-9.
6. All Dodge County arrestees booked into the jail are screened daily for treatment needs. 56 were screened October – December. 53 indicated a need for treatment and were given information on treatment resources. Seven were enrolled in treatment and case management under the TAP grant.

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
