- 5. BJA update: There has been no activity to date as the release of funds is pending. The program evaluator from UW-Whitewater will conduct his on-site visit on April 16-17. The BJA Technical Assistance site visit will take place July 8-9.
- 6. All Dodge County arrestees booked into the jail are screened daily for treatment needs. 56 were screened October December. 53 indicated a need for treatment and were given information on treatment resources. Seven were enrolled in treatment and case management under the TAP grant.
