

Dodge County Board of Supervisors
November 10, 2021 – 6:00 p.m.

The November 10, 2021 meeting of the Dodge County Board of Supervisors was called to order by Chairman Russell Kottke at 6:03 p.m.

The Board rose to say the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll call was taken by the Chief Deputy County Clerk with all Supervisors being in attendance with exception of Supervisors Fink, Greshay, Guckenberger, Hilbert, Houchin, Johnson, Kemmel, Kenevan, Macheel, Maly, Priesgen, Schultz, Yaroch who had previously asked to be excused, and Supervisors Berres, Caine and Siegmann.

Chairman Kottke introduced Brett Remington, President of Blue Rock WI, who recapped the main ideas of the strategic plan. Mr. Remington distributed worksheets to the Board members for the continuation of the development of action plans for the strategic priorities. Mr. Remington gave broad examples of action plans for the Quality of Life priority and asked the members to divide into groups and add action items for the five priorities.

Mr. Remington distributed draft mission statements, vision statements and core values and asked members to review them, and to be prepared to talk about them in December.
