

RE: Dodge County ARPA Funds

To: Dodge County Board of Supervisors

Dear Dodge County Board of Supervisors,

I am writing on behalf of the Friends of Lomira Parks organization, a non-profit group founded with the mission of improving the parks, green spaces, and recreational programming within the village of Lomira. Our organization was formally organized in May of 2021, and received non-profit status from the federal government in July of 2021. Shortly after organizing our group, we surveyed stakeholders in the community regarding parks and recreational opportunities, and we discovered that improving our largest park and playground is one of the top priorities of residents.

The Sterr Park Playground Project began in June of 2021, when a citizen in the village of Lomira donated funds for a large piece of playground equipment. This donation drove our organization to begin fundraising for additional pieces of new equipment in order to update and replace the aging equipment in Sterr Park. The privately donated equipment was delivered and installed in September and October of 2021, and the Friends of Lomira Parks used our funds to reimburse the village for the wood chips for the playground surfacing.

Our organization is working to raise funds for additional pieces of equipment, and we have already purchased a new swing set for the park, to be installed in Spring 2022. We are hoping to continue to fundraise in the next 18 months, and to purchase and install the remaining pieces of equipment in our plan by 2024. We have secured funds for this project through fundraising events, including brat fries, our Brews and Qs trivia and beer garden event, and through donations from organizations such as the Lomira FFA, the Lomira Fire Auxiliary, the Oakfield

The Friends of Lomira Parks is a 501(c)(3) non-profit, charitable organization. Contributions and donations are tax deductible.

VFW, the Lomira Lions Club, the Lomira Clover Leaves 4H club, and the Kenneth Immel Memorial Fund. We have also received donations from Kondex in Lomira, and from private citizens.

We are respectfully requesting \$50,000 from the Dodge County ARPA funds. The funds we are requesting will help us purchase the remaining playground equipment in our Sterr Park Playground Plan. Any remaining funds would be combined with our continued fundraising efforts to be used to purchase playground surfacing materials and to pay for the installation of the equipment.

The possible partnership between Dodge County and the Friends of Lomira Parks would greatly benefit residents of the Village of Lomira. Our parks are in need of ADA accessible paths, improved parking, updated shelters, and newer, safer playground equipment. Funds from this project will give us a jumpstart on bringing our residents improved access to healthy, family-friendly activities. Lomira is conveniently located off of Interstate 41, and many visitors who stop off the highway find themselves at Sterr Park to enjoy our fishing pond, our swimming pool, the local farmers market that is hosted weekly at the park in summer, and our playground. Improvements to our park through ARPA funds will improve the quality of life for residents in our community and will attract visitors from beyond Lomira!

This project meets ARPA requirements as an "investment in neighborhoods to promote improved health outcomes" (P. 20 Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds: Overview of Final Rule). I would also consider our non-profit to be a group that was impacted by the coronavirus. Community members had discussed organizing a group like Friends of Lomira Parks prior to coronavirus, however, the pandemic definitely delayed our ability to organize and fundraise. Friends of Lomira Parks has had to be mindful of meeting and fundraising in ways that are safe and healthy for participants.


