

Dodge County Board of Supervisors

Chairman David Frohling called the October 26, 2022 meeting of the Dodge County Board of Supervisors to order at 6:00 p.m.

The Board rose to say the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll call was taken by the Clerk with all Supervisors being in attendance with the exception of Supervisors Greshay, Johnson, and Yaroch, who had previously asked to be excused. Supervisors Conway and Sheahan-Malloy appeared virtually. Supervisor Siegmann arrived at 6:10 p.m.

Chairman Frohling asked Cameron Clapper, County Administrator, to present the 2023 proposed County budget. Administrator Clapper provided an in-depth presentation on the Sheriff's Office, Highway, Human Services and Health Department, Emergency Management, and Physical Facilities Departmental budgets. Discussion by Board members, and staff on the budgets and budget procedures. The Administrator continued with brief presentations on remaining department budgets. County Board members asked questions on individual budgets.

At 9:05 p.m., Supervisor Boelk made a motion to adjourn until Tuesday, November 1, 2022, at 6:00 p.m. Supervisor Steger seconded the motion. The motion carried by voice vote.
