- All trails are two-way trails.

Trail Descriptions

<u>Orange Trail:</u> The orange trail will connect the Southern end of the park to the rest of the trails on the North end. Make your way through the campground on a short loop for a view of the Rock River.

<u>Green Trail:</u> Watch for eagles as you enter the marsh and head towards the Rock River. Connect up with the ungroomed trail shown in black on the South East corner for a nice river view all the way to the boardwalk.

Red Trail: Nice flat trail that includes both views of the farm fields and a wooded connector route to the green trail.

<u>Blue Trail:</u> You may find the hills a challenge on this trail but they are worth it with a nice view of the farm fields.

<u>Yellow Trail:</u> This trail winds its way through the grassy open area of the park. As you approach the woods you'll find ungroomed connections to the Eagles Boardwalk and Pond View Trail.
