- Please keep all foot/pet traffic to the side of ski tracks.
- Ski tracks will be set when snow conditions allow.
- Grooming will take place 1-2 times per week as conditions allow.
- All trails are two-way trails.

Trail Descriptions

Park Roads: Groomed trails will twist and turn through park roads and campsites. It's mostly wooded and relatively flat with just a few small hills, don't forget to check out the scenic overlook!!

Gray/Yellow Trails: Take the groomed roads to these two loops each a ½ mile long. They will take you through the heavily wooded areas of the park. Be sure to watch for deer and enjoy the peace and quiet of the woods! If using the trail in limited snow be sure to watch your step as tree roots and rocks may be exposed.

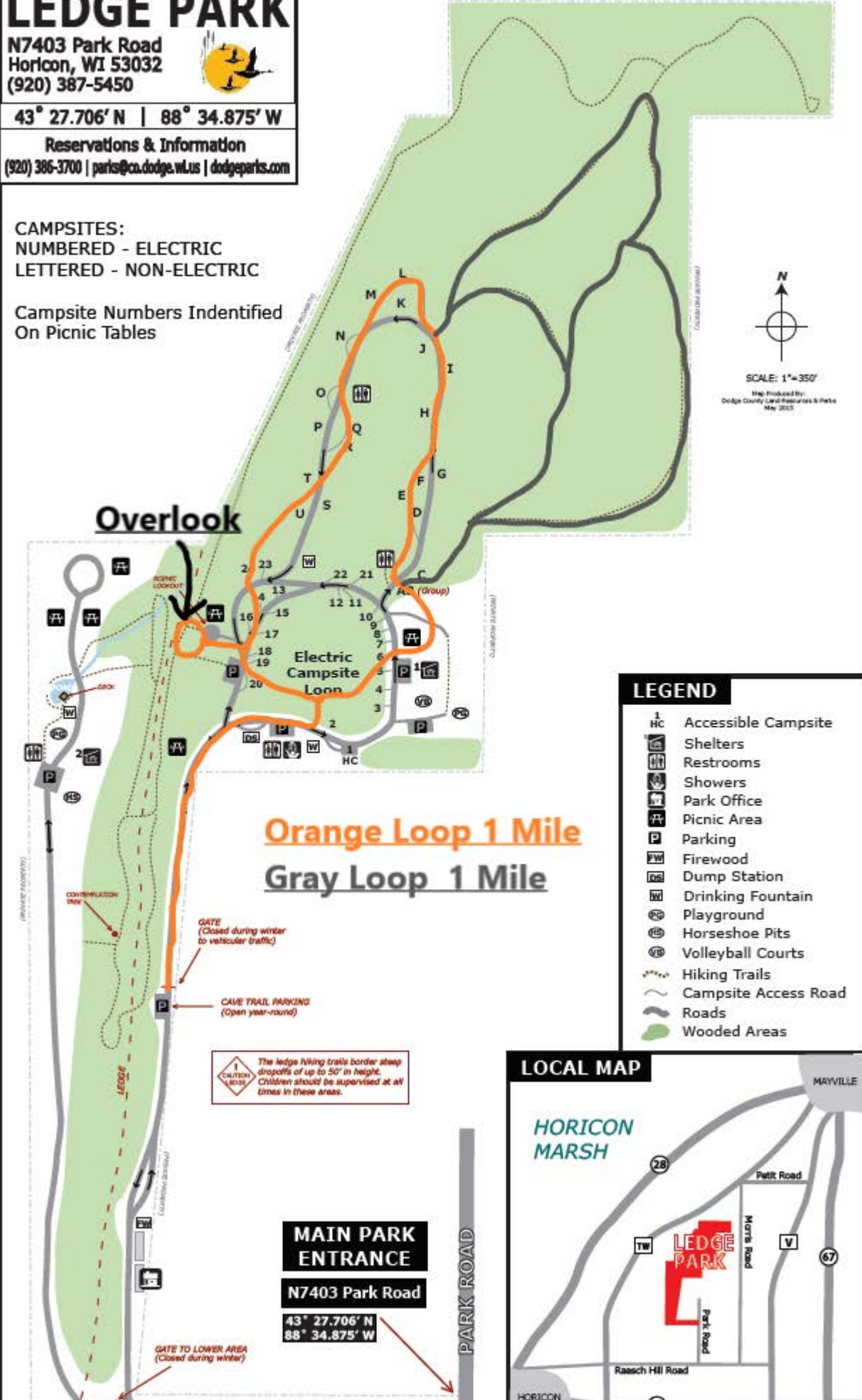
