- Please keep all foot/pet traffic to the side of ski tracks.
- Ski tracks will be set when snow conditions allow.
- Grooming will take place 1-2 times per week as conditions allow.
- All trails are two-way trails.

Trail Descriptions

Green Trail: Short and flat trail with nice view of the pond.

Yellow Trail: Variety of wooded, marsh and open space trails. This unique trail provides great views of the Nitschke Mound Group. Please be sure to stay on the trail and not to disturb the mounds in any way.

Red Trail: This 1 mile trail takes you from Nitschke Mounds Park to the Wild Goose State Trail. Watch carefully for ATV, UTV and Snowmobile traffic as you cross the Wild Goose State Trail and continue on your way down the groomed horse trail. See if you can spot the giant cottonwood tree along this trail, bet you can't fit your arms around it!!!

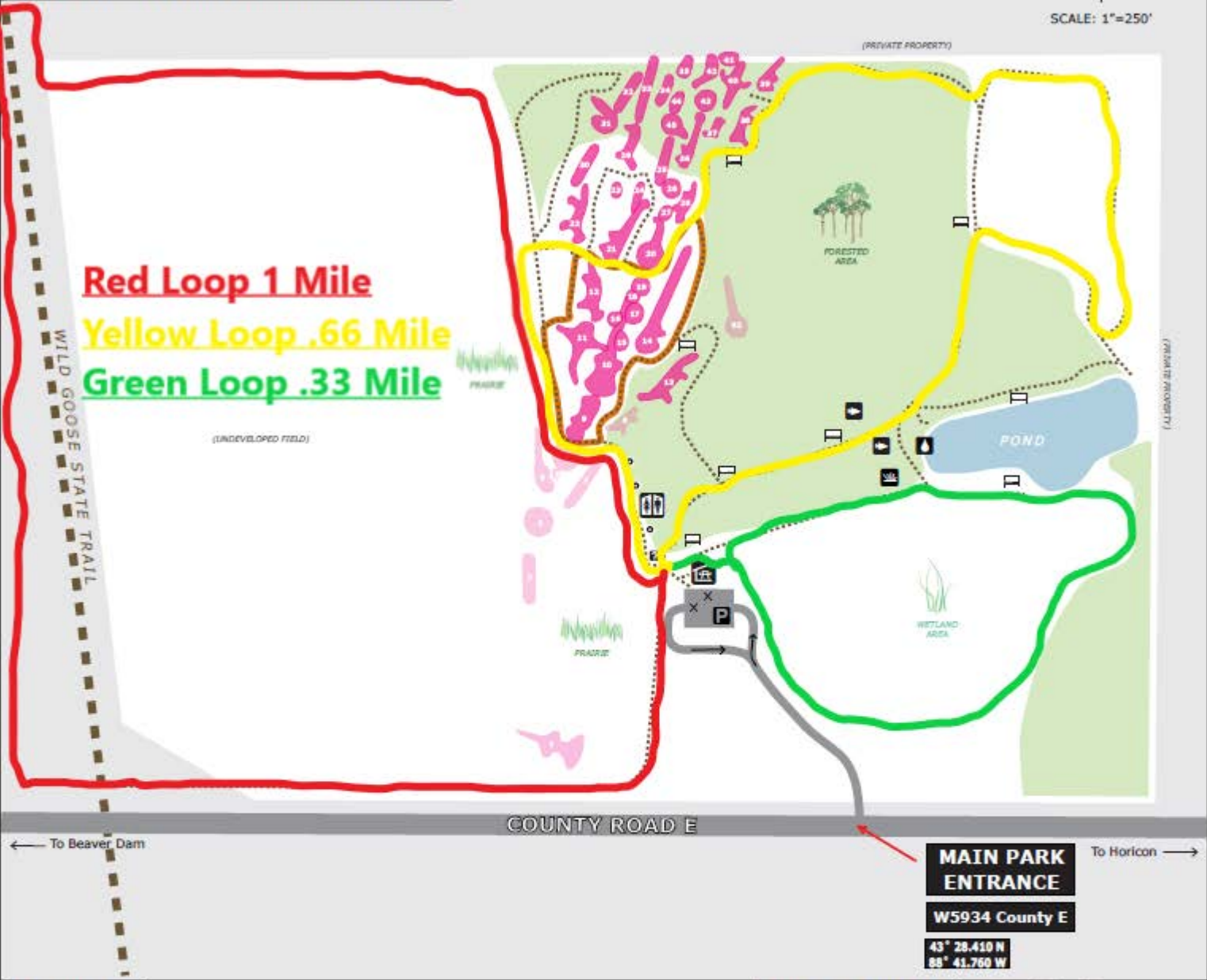
