#### PUBLIC HEARING - 7:15 P.M.

Russell Warren & Kathleen Schmitt for a variance to the terms of the impervious surface area provisions section 9.3 of the Dodge County Shoreland Protection Ordinance. Section 9.3 allows 15%, (10,382.5 square feet) of this lot, located within 300 feet of the ordinary highwater mark of the lake, can be covered with impervious surface area. As proposed, the total impervious surface area for this lot, as calculated by the County, including the detached shed and the additional concrete driveway, will be approximately 11,995 square feet in area or 1,612.5 square feet in impervious surface area more than allowed by the Ordinance and therefore prohibited.

The site located on Lot 29 First Addition to Miller's Woods, located in part of the NE ¼ of the NE ¼, Section 1, Town of Calamus, the site address being W9726 Cousins Court. A copy of the proposed petition is available for review in the County Land Resources and Parks Department between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., Monday-Friday (920-386-3700).

Michael Merk, agent for Mark, Christina and Franklin Mueller and Mueller Farms of Lomira, LLC — Request for an extension of a previously approved variance (2021-0878) to the terms of the setback provisions of the Dodge County Land Use Code to allow the construction of a manure storage facility and a feed storage pad where said manure storage facility will be located 190 feet within the required setback to a road right-of-way and which encroaches over a lot line and where said feed storage pad will encroach over a lot line.
