Note: These are guidelines for establishing an adult guardianship of the **person, estate or with Protective Placement** (if Ward is in a facility with more than 16 beds). This guideline is provided as a public service and is not intended to be legal advice.

A guardianship action is a court procedure to appoint someone called a "guardian" to make medical and/or financial decisions for an incompetent person called the "ward". You may retain an attorney to complete the forms and appear at the guardianship hearing, but the law does allow individuals to petition the court without an attorney. This can be a very complicated procedure and because the Register in Probate and their staff are unable to give you legal advice, we urge you to consult with an attorney about this process.

- ❖ A packet of forms is available from the Register in Probate for \$5.00.

- Complete the below forms and either mail them to us or drop them off at the Dodge County Probate Office.
- ❖ The Register in Probate will review your paperwork and will deposit your Guardian ad Litem Trust payment of \$250.00.
- ❖ The Register in Probate will appoint a Guardian ad Litem, schedule a hearing and generate an order appointing Guardian ad Litem.
- When you pick up the paperwork you will be given a copy of the paperwork to serve on all interested persons.
- The Affidavit of Service needs to be completed after you serve the documents on the interested persons and file it with the Court **before** the hearing.

#### MANDATORY GUARDIANSHIP TRAINING

Prior to being appointed as a permanent guardian over an adult ward you must complete the required training and submit proof that you have completed this training to the court. Once training is complete, print off the certificate of completion and submit with form GN-3135.

This is course is self-paced and is accessible 24/7. If an individual does not have access to a computer and/or Wi-Fi, they can find a list of free public computers and internet access in their county through the link on our website.

**Court Hearing**: If the petition complies with §54.34, Wis. Stats., a hearing on the petition will be scheduled before a judge. The Petitioner and proposed Guardian must be present in court to testify at the hearing. The Court is required to conclude the petition within 90 days of filing.

#### **SERVICE OF DOCUMENTS:**

- ❖ The Petitioner <u>shall</u> serve a copy of the Petition for Guardianship and the Order and Notice of Hearing on the proposed ward by personal service no less than 10 days prior to the hearing date.
- ❖ The Petitioner shall also provide notice to all other interested persons, including the Guardian ad Litem, either in person or by mail at least 10 days prior to the hearing. All interested parties must receive notice of this hearing. See §54.38(2)(a) and (b), Wis. Stats.
- Note: Failure to provide notice as required by statute will deprive the court of jurisdiction over this case and the case may be dismissed or the hearing may be rescheduled.

# All documents necessary for the hearing must be filed at least 96 hours (4 days) prior to the hearing.

## After Appointment of Guardian:

- ❖ Copies of Documents: Make copies of all documents for your records before you file the documents with our office. If staff makes copies for you, there is a \$1.00/page fee per §814.66, Wis. Stats.
- ❖ Certified Copies: If certified copies are required, the statutory cost is \$3.00 for the certificate and \$1.00 for each page copied or compared per §814.66, Wis. Stats.

## If you are appointed **GUARDIAN OF THE PERSON** you must:

GN-3480 Annual Report on the Condition of the Ward. The re	report must be filed no later than April 15 <sup>th</sup> .
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## If you are appointed **GUARDIAN OF THE ESTATE** you must:

- File an inventory (see link below) within <u>60 days</u> listing all of the assets of the ward (even if zero assets) as of the date you are appointed and pay the mandatory inventory filing fee (see below).
- ❖ File an annual Account of the Guardian Form GN-3500 listing all financial activity from the time you are appointed to December 31 of the same year. The annual account must be filed no later than April 15. The probate court office will mail out this form each year. If you do not receive it, it is your responsibility to obtain a blank form from <a href="http://www.wicourts.gov/forms1/circuit.htm">http://www.wicourts.gov/forms1/circuit.htm</a>.
