

**Dodge County Board of Supervisors  
October 31, 2023 – 6:00 p.m.  
Administration Building - Juneau, Wisconsin**

The October 31, 2023, Meeting of the Dodge County Board of Supervisors was called to order by Chairman David Frohling at 6:00 p.m.

The Board rose to say the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll call was taken by the Clerk with all Supervisors being in attendance with exception of Supervisors Houchin, Maly, Sheahan-Malloy, and Yaroch who had previously asked to be excused. Supervisor Guckenberger was absent.

**2024 Dodge County Budget Appropriation Public Hearing**

Chairman Frohling called upon Karen Gibson, County Clerk, to confirm the publication of the Affidavit for the Public Hearing Notice. Ms. Gibson read the Affidavit of Publication and stated the notice was published on October 14, 2023, in the Beaver Dam Daily Citizen.

The Chairman declared the Public Hearing open at 6:02 p.m. and asked anyone who wished to speak to come forward.

**Andrew J. Schnitzler** – 100 Pine Drive, Reeseville WI, 53579 – Spoke against 2024 Budget expenditures related to road construction. Mr. Schnitzler provided the board with a visual aid of information gathered to support his comments.

Chairman Frohling declared the Public Hearing closed at 6:12 p.m.

**County Board Discussion on 2024 Dodge County Budget**

Chairman Frohling opened the floor for County Board Supervisors to participate in a budget discussion with the County Administrator and Department Directors on the proposed 2024 Budget. The main points of discussion were health insurance cost adjustments, road construction schedules, employee positions, and policies. Following the discussion, Chairman Frohling and Clerk Gibson made statements regarding the timeline and deadlines for agendas and amendments.

- Thursday, November 2, 2023 – All anticipated amendments should be submitted to the Finance department so they can be added to the agenda for the Finance Committee meeting scheduled on November 6, 2023.
- Friday, November 10, 2023, by 12:00 p.m. – Any additional anticipated amendments need to be submitted in writing so they can be included on an amended agenda for the November 14, 2023, County Board meeting.

At 7:27 p.m., Supervisor Boelk made a motion to adjourn until Tuesday, November 14, 2023, at 9:00 a.m. Supervisor Caine seconded the motion. The motion to adjourn carried by voice vote.
