

Dodge County Board of Supervisors October 31, 2024 – 6:00 p.m. Administration Building - Juneau, Wisconsin

The October 31, 2024, Meeting of the Dodge County Board of Supervisors was called to order by Chairman David Frohling at 6:00 p.m.

2025 Dodge County Budget Appropriation Public Hearing

Chairman Frohling called upon Danielle J. Van Egtern, County Clerk, to confirm the publication of the Affidavit for the Public Hearing Notice. Ms. Van Egtern read the Affidavit of Publication and stated the notice was published on October 15, 2024, in the Beaver Dam Daily Citizen.
