You may not cross over party lines. You must select a party and then cast a vote for individual candidates.**

**REFERNDUM**

ADVISORY REFERENDUM

Shall the City of Waupun, with a \$1 million dollar contribution from Fond Du Lac County, consider one of the following options for the development or improvement of an aquatic facility in the City of Waupun:

(Vote for Only One Option)

**Option No.1:**

Construct a 6,234 sq. ft. zero entry pool with swim lanes, shade structures, diving towers, water slides, water features, and bathhouse with concession area at Fond du Lac County Park, at a total estimated cost of \$2.91-\$3.12 million dollars. If selected, this option would be funded by a contribution of \$1.0 million dollars from Fond du Lac County and an estimated \$1.91-\$2.12 million dollars from the City of Waupun

Option No. 2:

Construct an additional 3,950 sq. ft. zero entry pool with swim lanes, shade structures, water slides, water features, and bathhouse with concession area at the current McCune Beach site, at a total estimated cost of \$2.15 million dollars. If selected, this option would be funded by a contribution of \$1.0 million dollars from Fond du Lac County and an estimated \$1.15 million dollars from the City of Waupun.

Option No. 3:

Improve the current 15,000 sq. ft. McCune Beach site with a newly constructed bathhouse with concession area and other additional physical upgrades, at a total estimated cost of \$1.0 million dollars. If selected, this option would be funded exclusively by a contribution of \$1.0 million dollars from Fond du Lac County, with no additional contribution from the City of Waupun anticipated.
